

Chakola Walking Tracks



“Top Track” starts behind the ‘Big Barn’ and follows the fence along the neighbouring paddock, returning through the turpentine forest. Approx 800m / 15mins return

“River Track” starts at the Conservation Area sign below the main hall and follows the original bridal path below the escarpment to the river, then upstream to the ‘dry river bed’ and ‘Canoe Pond’. Approx 2km / 50-60mins return

“Cliff Track” heads north from the main hall past the firewood area before descending steeply to the ‘Canoe Pond’. The lower section is less well defined and flood erosion may make final access to the river difficult. Approx 1.2km / 30-40mins return

“River Track” connects with “Cliff Track” at ‘Canoe Pond’

Less used short-cut tracks are indicated in yellow

Always wear appropriate footwear. Do not walk alone

There is no mobile coverage below the escarpment
